Personal Possessions Information and Guidance

When your loved one comes to Meddyg Care, we always encourage that they arrive with as many of their homely possessions as would be practicable. Feeling at home and creating an environment to support a feeling of belonging is a vital part of the transition to living at Meddyg Care.

We would like to highlight that some residents with dementia are unable to control behaviours. This can result in possessions being broken, destroyed, moved, or lost. With this in mind could we please ask that all items are clearly labelled with your loved one's name on. Items including photo albums, pictures in frames, teddies, blankets, cushions etc.

If an item is of high value or of high sentimental value, we strongly suggest that you do not bring the item into the home. Items such as money or jewellery. We would also ask that any photos that are brought into the home are also copies and not the original.

We do not accept responsibility for the safekeeping, maintenance, servicing, or replacement of any item of personal possessions brought into Meddyg Care. Unless damage is caused by the negligent actions of a member of staff working at Meddyg Care.

We will ensure a record of valuables are kept and updated when new possessions are delivered to the Head Office. We advise that you do not take possessions directly to the home, this is to ensure that all new items are documented. If items are delivered directly to the home and a receipt is not provided for the items Meddyg Care do not accept any responsibility or liability for these items.

We would ask that everything is brought to head office where a receipt will be provided by the Family Liaison Officer.

We would ask that iron on labels are not used to label items of clothing. Due to the temperatures at which clothing must be washed for hygiene and Covid protocol reasons these labels do not withstand high temperatures or drying in our commercial dryers.

We do not have the facility for hand washing or air drying. All clothing must be suitable for tumble drying. It is for this reason we cannot accept any wool items of clothing.
