Staff have probationary meetings at various stages of their initial appointment to discuss their progress. Staff receive one-to-one supervision on a regular basis and spot checks are carried out to monitor the quality of care being delivered. Systems are in place to ensure staff are supported and able to reach people for help and support when needed.

Our dedicated HR Manager records all staff pre-employment checks and ongoing support and development.
